Room Reservations

Transportation to the Hotel (Also see attachment flyer from hotel)

There are several ways to get to the hotel from the San Francisco Airport. We suggest that you do NOT rent a car, it really won't be necessary and parking at the hotel is expensive (\$42.00 a day). Here are some options:

- 1. BART (Bay Area Rapid Transit) This will be the cheapest way but the nearest drop to the hotel is about 5 blocks. If you have trouble walking or a lot of luggage you will not want this option
- 2. Taxi This is very expensive (about \$45 one way) Shuttle van or bus is probably the most economical and best way. You can book online and prepay (suggested) for each of the following companies: Go Lorries – 415.334.9000 or www.gosfovan.com;
