## **Room Reservations**

Rooms will be released for reservations on Monday, March 17<sup>th</sup>. There are a few things you need to be aware of when making room reservations. Based on lessons we learned from last year and conversations with the hotel on how to make things easier for them and for us we have made a few adjustments to the process of reserving rooms. We hope that you will see the benefits of these adjustments and will follow the steps we have put in place. The hotel is acting upon the request of the convention team so if you have any problems or questions please contact Tami. So...here goes:

- 1. If you are a chapter President calling in to make reservations for your chapter **please have your delegate names ready to give to the hotel for each room you are reserving.** You will be allowed to reserve multiple rooms on one card to make it easier but you MUST have names. We are hopeful that the names you are giving will be your delegates. Last year, many chapters reserved more rooms than they needed, and then released them closer to convention; we want to avoid that this year. We really want as many of you as possible to stay at the MMC and get the full experience of convention so PLEASE be mindful of others when making your reservations. PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU DO NOT HAVE NAMES YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RESERVE ROOMS.
- 2. You will be able to request rollaway beds but you will be charged \$10 + tax per night for each rollaway you request. Most rooms will accommodate one rollaway but you should confirm with the hotel.
- 3. With your room reservation each person in the room is issued a Hospitality Pass that allows you breakfast and the complimentary happy hour. If a room will accommodate 2 people and you have 4 people in your room, there will be a \$20 + tax charge for the extra 2 people per night for the Hospitality pass. If you are in a suite or room that accommodates 2-4 people, any over that amount will be charged the extra \$20 + tax per night.
- 4. Please keep in mind that there are very few double/double rooms available so please, carefully consider what your needs are and make reservations accordingly.

## How you can help

Convention is a huge undertaking but it is totally worth it and it truly is just around the corner! We want to have another successful convention, but we need your help. Below are some suggestions on how you can help us:
